DRESS CODE FOR 2009-2010

Standard of Dress

No printing, advertising, or logos may appear on or be seen through any clothing except sports teams names on outer garment such as sweatshirts and jackets. the small brand logos, such as the old Izod gator, are also acceptable.

Pants- Solid color slacks in navy, gray or khaki

Fabric: cords, twill, gabardine, chino

Hems: neatly and securely stitched

No cargo pants

Waistbands: fitted and worn at the waist (above the hipbone)

Shorts: walking short style, no more than 2 inches above knee and may not be below the knee. Navy, gray or khaki. Cargo shorts are OK

Skirts/Skortts: no more than 4 inches above the knee in navy, khaki or plaid

Shirts/blouses (must have collars)

Polo shirt, long or short sleeve

Colors: any; solid colors or stripes

Turtlenecks any color

shirts with tails must be tucked in and all others should fall no more than 4 inches below the waist. Only top layered shirt should be visible.

Sweatshirt, crew neck or hooded style (Uniform shirt to be worn underneath sweatshirts)

Colors: any except black

V-neck sweater vest, crew neck or cardigan sweater (Uniform shirt to be worn underneath) Colors: any solid or plaid

Socks/tights Color: Any; must be worn with all shoes; sandals with heel straps may be worn without socks.

Girls: tights, knee-highs or panty hose are permitted

Shoes/Sandals must have a closed heel or heel strap

Hats are to be removed at all times inside the building.

Coats or jackets must be worn when teachers judge the weather warrants it. Coats or jackets may not be worn inside.

Bare waists, bare midriffs, bare backs and low necklines are not permitted. Tattoos, both permanent and temporary, marking or drawing on skin with pen or marker are not permitted. Green hair only on special occasions.

Body piercing other than ears is not permitted.

Clothing may be purchased from any vendor as long as all pieces meet the above stated criteria. The principal must give prior approval for uniforms from other youth organizations (like Scouts, Campfire, etc) to be worn on the days of their meetings.

Chapel Day Colors - It is requested, but not required, that on Wednesdays students dress in combinations that include only gray, navy or white

Dress code applies to students in all grades, Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 8; to be worn everyday from the first day of school until the last, including field trips. However, it will be at the discretion of the principal to schedule occasional "free dress" days. Some field trips may warrant other appropriate attire and that decision will be made by the teacher and principal.

When students come to school without their uniform, the policy is:

First time in quarter: Student will receive written warning from the teacher which the parents will have to sign and return.

Second time: **Student** will call a parent, who in turn will have to bring a uniform to school so that the student can change.

Third time: Student will be sent home by the principal.
